TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

The Roman Canon, called Eucharistic Prayer I, is probably seldom heard in your parish. Some priests will choose it for at least one of the Masses of Christmas, or the Easter Vigil. Such sparing use of this prayer seems strange, especially since it was the only Eucharistic Prayer in the Latin Rite for many centuries, from as long ago as 500 right up to 1970.

In 1965, the vernacular language was approved for the canon of the Mass.

Almost immediately, some experimental texts began to surface in the Netherlands, and priests began to use new Dutch texts without permission. By 1966, Pope Paul VI had set up a committee to consider whether or not it was time to approve such experimentation and extend it to non-Dutch churches. No sooner had the committee been formed than other individuals copied the Dutch by just plunging on ahead. The Dutch bishops had approved the use of the new prayers nationwide in 1968, and Flemish bishops in Belgium quickly agreed. By then, German translations of the Dutch prayers were in wide use, and before long nearly one hundred Eucharistic Prayers, all unapproved, were in circulation in France. The Vatican heard the widespread desire for more variety in Eucharistic Prayer forms, and, with the pope's approval, the process of creating new official prayers began.

NOTHING TO FEAR

A rabbi was asked why God sends trials and troubles into human lives. "Because God gets lonely for his people" was the reply. There is some resonance with this wisdom in today's Gospel, as Jesus makes his disciples get into a boat without him and goes off alone while they venture into stormy waters. Of course, neither Jews nor Christians believe that the Almighty plays this sort of whimsical game with them, but there is some truth in the statement that we don't turn to God for saving help until we're in a bind. Peter's role today, as it is throughout the New Testament, is to be a sign or to represent each member of the church and the whole church. Our story is the tale told about Peter's faith today. What can bolster our faith is that even when Christ calls us to face bravely the tempests of life, if we are walking through them with our eyes fixed on him in faith, we have nothing to fear. Even when we falter or sink, simply crying "Lord, save me!" is enough to help us know the steady grasp of God's hand. Then, sheltered inside the walls of faith, the storms we endure lose their power over us.

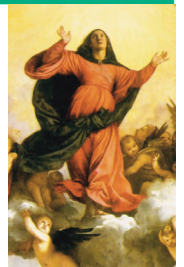
ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

STRENGTHENING THE CHURCH AT HOME

The Diocese of Knoxville in eastern Tennessee is a largely rural diocese that bears the face of the rural poor. The Hispanic population has more than doubled in the last few years and poverty disproportionately affects this community.

Through your support of the Catholic Home Missions Appeal (CHMA), the diocese is expanding its Hispanic ministry programs. With your contributions, it is distributing prayer cards, providing Hispanic leadership training and faith formation, and increasing the number of parishes celebrating Mass in Spanish in order to help integrate and retain this population. One parish only held Mass monthly and attendance was a low 20-50 people, but staff recognized the large Hispanic community there and the need

for a Spanish Mass. A priest travels 60 miles each Sunday to celebrate Mass in Spanish, and attendance has nearly doubled.

In another part of the country, in the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings in Montana, 99 parishes and missions are spread over 90,000 square miles. Many priests in the diocese serve multiple parishes, and some serve up to five! Many parishes cannot meet the financial obligations of having a full-time priest, and communities often feel disconnected from the larger Church. With your support of CHMA, the diocese ensures that priests can make the necessary travel to serve their flocks and that parishes can keep their doors open. The support from this appeal has touched the people in this diocese and allowed them to keep their

faith communities active and connected to the universal Church.

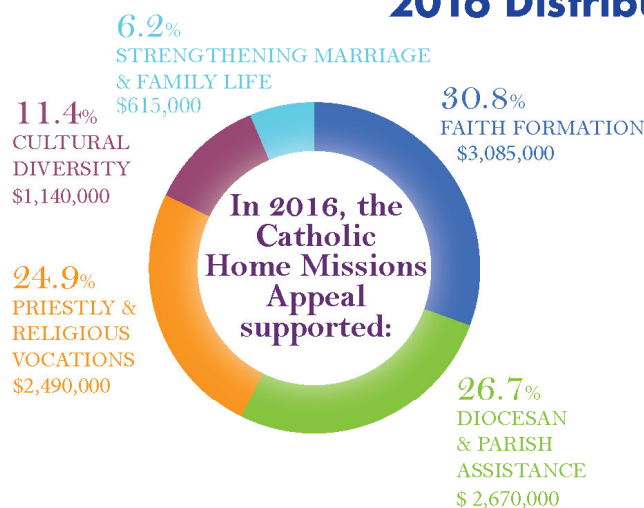

What Is a Home Mission Diocese?

Home mission dioceses are those dioceses in the United States and its territories and former territories that cannot provide basic pastoral services to Catholics without outside help. Basic pastoral services include Mass and the sacraments, religious education, and ministry training for priests, deacons, religious sisters, and lay people. Right now, over 40 percent of dioceses are considered home missions.

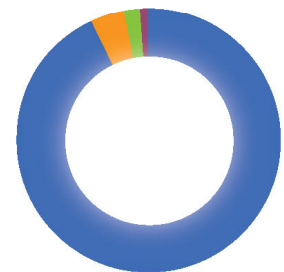
2016 Distribution of Funding

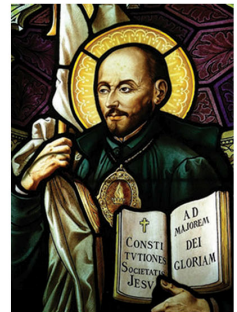

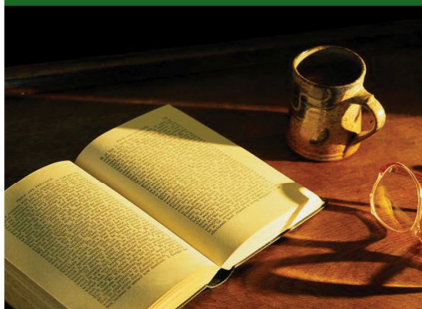

Retreat in Daily Life (RIDL) is the common designation of the 19th Annotation St. Ignatius of Loyola wrote into his Spiritual Exercises. These spiritual exercises evolved through St. Ignatius' own experience as he transformed from a soldier to a servant of our loving God. As you mirror his prayerful journey, following the life, teachings, death and resurrection of Jesus, you will prayerfully encounter a loving God and desire to become all you were created to be.

FIRST STEPS: If you are interested in RIDL, contact one of the facilitators listed to schedule an initial interview. Interviews will take place July 1 through August 31. The interview process is an opportunity for you to learn more about the retreat, to discern with a facilitator whether or not you are ready to make the retreat at this time, and to begin prayer practices that prepare a person for the retreat experience.

FORMAT: During the course of 30 weeks--from October through April--retreatants live their commitment to God, to themselves and to their fellow participants by following the steps of this prayer journey. Each retreatant commits to these three experiences:

- Daily private prayer, which includes Scripture, reflection, and journaling.
- Weekly small group meetings in which participants share their prayer experiences with each other. Groups are facilitated by a certified spiritual director.
- Twice monthly individual spiritual direction.

FEES: The fee for the retreat is \$70.00 per month. The stipend for twice-monthly Spiritual Direction is \$20.00 per session.

In keeping with the Rule of St. Benedict governing hospitality, those who have been blessed with more may wish to contribute more, and those who have less give less so that "all may be at peace in the house of God."

Individual 19th annotation retreat experiences will be considered upon request.

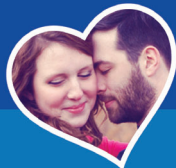

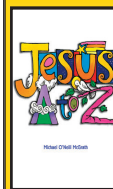
