# TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

ALL THAT YOU HAVE DONE TO US, O LORD, YOU HAVE DONE WITH TRUE JUDGMENT, FOR WE HAVE SINNED AGAINST YOU AND NOT OBEYED YOUR COMMANDMENTS. BUT GIVE GLORY TO YOUR NAME AND DEAL WITH US ACCORDING TO THE BOUNTY OF YOUR MERCY. DANIEL 3:31,29,30,43,42

## TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

Eucharistic Prayer IV is, like Eucharistic Prayer III, a fresh composition from the 1960s, based on a prayer from the tradition of the ancient church of Alexandria. It has an interesting structural feature. The new prayers all nod toward the East with the epiclesis, or calling down of the Spirit, over the gifts. In this prayer the Spirit is asked to come down again, after the consecration, to make holy the communicants who "partake of this one Bread and one Chalice that, gathered into one body by the Holy Spirit, they may truly become a living sacrifice in Christ to the praise of your glory." This beautiful phrase is well worth meditating on. What is the goal of your reception of Holy Communion today?

The preface for this Eucharistic Prayer is firmly attached to the prayer, and the directives for using the prayer anchor it to Ordinary Time. It is not intended to be an option if the Mass has a proper preface of its own, like a funeral, a Lenten weekday, or a great feast. It is not often used these days, in part because of these limitations. At first, it was suggested that this prayer was better suited to small groups of people who were well educated in scripture. This was kind of an odd stipulation, especially since its images are so beautiful and worthy of attention.

## GOD'S WAYS

In the stream of readings during this portion of Ordinary Time one week's texts can often appear to pick up exactly where the previous week's concluded. The sentiments expressed in today's first reading seem to be a direct reaction to the Gospel passage we heard last week. In that Gospel, the landowner pays the same wages to his workers whether they worked for a full day or for only a few minutes. Today Ezekiel gives us the lament, "The LORD's way is not fair!" (Ezekiel 18:25). These Sundays in Ordinary Time offer us a glimpse into the ways of the Lord. We see how God's way has the tendency to turn the accepted conventions of the day upside down. Those who always expected that their way to heaven was guaranteed are disappointed. Those who thought they never had a chance are given that chance. Today offers us another opportunity to discover the abundance of God's mercy and love.

## REFLECTING ON GOD'S WORD

In *The Secret Life of Bees*, August, an older black woman, is talking about "the problem with people" to Lily, a younger white woman who has run away from an abusive father. Lily has said that people don't really know what matters. But August says the deeper problem is that people do know what matters, but don't choose it.

God tells Ezekiel that virtue's proof is in choosing to do the right thing. What you choose to do matters. So be careful not to go off the right path at the end of your days. On the other hand, you might be off the right path for years, but end up hopping back on at the very end, and you will have life. It doesn't sound very fair; nevertheless, it's where you are when the end comes that counts. And you don't know when the end will come.

Jesus confronts the religious leaders with a parable. A father asks his two sons to do some work in the vineyard. One talks a good game but never makes it into the field; the other refuses outright, but then goes and does what his father asked. In telling this parable, Jesus compares these leaders unfavorably to the tax collectors and prostitutes. The elders must have been shocked.

"Have in you that same attitude that is also in Christ Jesus," writes Paul to his beloved Philippians. The attitude he urged on them was giving oneself for the sake of others—even unto death. In this way, we not only speak but also do "Yes." Choose to live Christ.

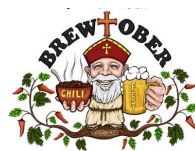
## DOMINICAN SISTERS OF MARY MOTHER OF THE EUCHARIST —VISIT NWA—

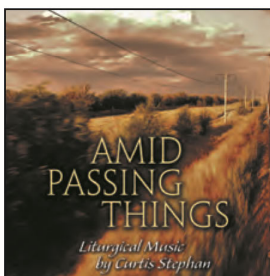

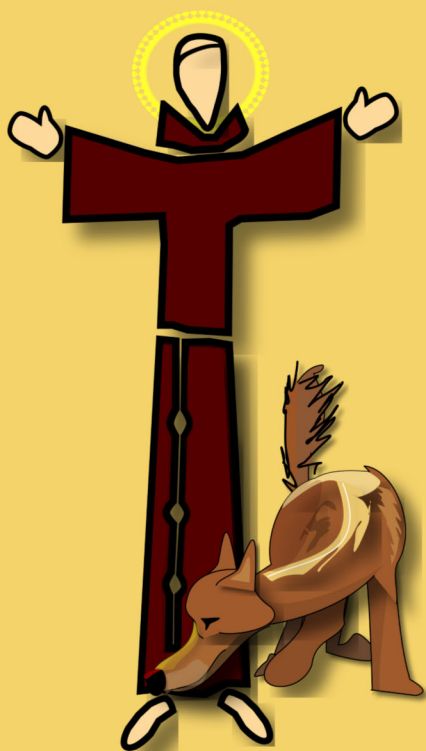

All donations over and above the loan payoff will go toward construction of a new church. A higher level of participation and support will enable us to move more quickly in the final phase of our parish's Master Plan.

## Adoración ofrece tesoro inmenso

TOMADO DE LA PÁGINA WEB DE LA DIÓCESIS DE LITTLE ROCK

*“La mayor historia de amor está contenida en una pequeña Hostia.” — Arzobispo Fulton J. Sheen.*

En repetidas ocasiones el Papa Francisco ha exhortado a los fieles a pasar tiempo ante Jesús en el Santísimo Sacramento. Él se une a muchos que han llegado antes que él para resaltar los frutos espirituales de la adoración Eucarística.

“La Iglesia y el mundo tienen una gran necesidad del culto Eucarístico. Jesús nos espera en este sacramento del amor. No escatimemos tiempo para ir a encontrarlo en la adoración, en la contemplación llena de fe y abierta a reparar las graves faltas y delitos del mundo. No cese nunca nuestra adoración” (San Juan Pablo II, Dominicae Cena, 3).

El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica que Jesús está verdaderamente presente — Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad — en la Eucaristía (1374). Y esta presencia “comienza en el momento de la consagración y dura todo el tiempo que subsistan las especies Eucarísticas”. Por lo tanto, la “Iglesia católica ha dado y continua dando este culto de adoración que se debe al sacramento de la Eucaristía no solamente durante la Misa, sino también fuera de su celebración: conservando con el mayor cuidado las hostias consagradas, presentándolas a los fieles para que las veneren con solemnidad, llevándolas en procesión en medio de la alegría del pueblo” (1378).

“¿Cuántos dicen ahora de Cristo: quisiera ver su forma, su figura, sus vestidos, su calzado? Pues helo ahí, a Él ves, a Él tocas, a Él comes. Él te concede no solo verle, sino comerle, tocarle, recibirle dentro de ti” — San Juan Crisóstomo.

Jesús dice a sus discípulos: “Yo estaré siempre con ustedes hasta el fin del mundo” (Mateo 28,20). A través de la Eucaristía Él ha cumplido su promesa de una manera palpable e íntima.

“Puesto que Cristo iba a dejar a los suyos bajo su forma visible, quiso darnos su presencia sacramental; puesto que iba a ofrecerse en la cruz por nuestra salvación, quiso que tuviéramos el memorial del amor con que nos había amado “hasta el fin”, hasta el don de su vida. En efecto, en su presencia Eucarística permanece misteriosamente en medio de nosotros como quien nos amó y se entregó por nosotros y se queda bajo los signos que expresan y comunican este amor” (catecismo, 1380).
