THE SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

OF YOU MY HEART HAS SPOKEN: SEEK HIS FACE. IT IS YOUR FACE, O LORD, THAT I SEEK; HIDE NOT YOUR FACE FROM ME.

PSALM 27:8-9

Abrams's faith is sealed with a covenant initiated by God (1), our light and our salvation (Ps). The transfiguration of Jesus (3) prefigures the transformation in glory to which we are called by our sharing in the paschal mystery—the dying and rising of Jesus (2).

FIRST READING—GENESIS 15:5-12

The Lord made a covenant with his faithful servant, Abram, saying, "To your descendants I give this land."

PSALM—PSALM 27

The Lord is my light and my salvation.

SECOND READING—PHILIPPIANS 3:17

We await the Lord Jesus, who will change us to conform with his glorified body.

GOSPEL—LUKE 9:28b-36

Peter, James, and John witness the transfiguration of Jesus on the mountain.

STAND FIRM IN THE LORD

It is not hard to imagine, in this age of wars, evil groups bent on the destruction of humanity, and political follies, that the words of Saint Paul were so accurate, even for his time. It seems that the world never changes. Paul says, "Many . . . conduct themselves as enemies of the cross of Christ. Their end is their destruction . . . Their minds are occupied with earthly things" (Philippians 3:18, 19). The result is the destruction of innocent people and of the Earth itself.

But Paul says to the Philippians, "our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we also await a savior, the Lord Jesus Christ" (3:20). He will "change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body" (3:21). Note that he says "body" rather than "bodies." He is talking about the whole community of believers, who, following the example of Jesus and of Paul, will come into the glory of God. So "stand firm in the Lord" (4:1).

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITIONS

By now, many may have failed in Lenten discipline to some measure or another: the daily doughnut is simply too alluring, or a furtive puff on a cigarette irresistible. There is meaning even in the failure, though, a kind of reminder that we cannot save ourselves. Part of the power of Lent is that we do it together, and although individuals decide on different ways to keep it, it is fundamentally the same journey. We fall, we get up, we keep moving. The desire to "give something up" for Lent is an age old impulse in the Christian heart. We get better at it over the years, and move more deeply into the meaning and message of acts of sacrifice; so there is no shame in stumbling, as long as we are not discouraged by the failure and give up. We are clearing space in our lives, after all, and some of the things we desire to give up are worth rooting out completely anyway.

What do we do with the space we have cleared out by our sacrifice? The Lenten question of giving up is balanced by the Easter question of our response to Christ's embrace of us in love: "What are you taking on for Easter?"

SECOND WEEK OF LENT: JOURNEY TO GUATAMALA

God of Hope, we encounter you in refugees.

In **Uganda**, we encounter Annet and her family, children forced to flee violence, searching for stability. Annet's youngest sister calls her mom—and for good reason. Since their parents' deaths 4 years ago, 16-year-old Annet has been caring for her three younger siblings, and it hasn't been easy. Ongoing violence in their home country, South Sudan, forced Annet to take her brother and sisters and flee to Uganda. Now they live in Bidi Bidi, one of the world's largest refugee settlements.



While Annet is happy to be away from the violence, life in Bidi Bidi is hard, especially for a young woman trying to raise her siblings. That's why CRS is building houses for families like Annet's. A place to call home means Annet can rest a little easier at night knowing her family is safe. While she wants to return to South Sudan, for now she knows that Bidi Bidi is the safer option. "My hope is to raise my siblings," she says, "and I know I can do it with the help of CRS and my Catholic faith."

ONECHURCH INITIATIVE

We invite you to join the Diocese of Little Rock's newest initiative. "One Church: Unite Arkansas in Faith and Mission" supports a rural mission in our diocese that needs a leg up to become a thriving community. This year's partner is St. Luke Church in Warren, a growing congregation in Southeast Arkansas whose decaying, older building can no longer accommodate them. The sanctuary is too small for their one Sunday night Mass so many people must stand outside or in the sacristy.

Thankfully St. Luke has an acquired the old farmers co-op and will be renovating it to meet their needs for decades to come. With donations from their parishioners and One Church, they will be able to renovate the warehouse and storefront to become their new sanctuary, classroom and office. The parish needs a one-time boost to help them pay for this venture.

Last Fall St. Joseph's youth ministry group got involved in supporting One Church. Our young people put together a simple "spare change" fund raiser and they brought in over \$1200 for St Luke's in Warren. The rest of the parish can get involved, too. Our second collection on March 30-31 will go to support the One Church initiative.

HONDURAS MISSION 2019

The Honduras Mission ministry would like to take the opportunity to thank each of you for your prayers, donations and assistance for our recent trip.

Thirty-seven (37) missionaries from our parish and Immaculate Conception Church in Ft. Smith recently returned from a very successful trip. Four physicians and staff were able to treat several hundred patients, our construction team built 50 classroom desks and 11 church pews, and our Evangelization team visited and taught children from four school communities in the area.

We are presently planning the dates for our next trip in 2020, which will be published in the bulletin.
