## SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

SEE, I HAVE GOD FOR MY HELP. THE LORD SUSTAINS MY SOUL. I WILL SACRIFICE TO YOU WITH WILLING HEART, AND PRAISE YOUR NAME, O LORD, FOR IT IS GOOD. PSALM 54:6

Abraham, the just and upright man (Ps), graciously hosts three visitors (1). As Mary and Martha host Jesus, he speaks of only one thing as necessary (3) for us who follow him: being open to receive the message and person of Jesus, and being receptive to the “mystery of Christ” (2) as he comes to us through one another.

### FIRST READING—GENESIS 18:1-10A

Abraham and Sarah show hospitality to messengers of the LORD.

### PSALM—PSALM 15

He who does justice will live in the presence of the Lord.

### SECOND READING—COLOSSIANS 1:24-28

Paul speaks of the stewardship given to him to complete the word of God, the mystery hidden from ages past.

### GOSPEL—LUKE 10:38-42

Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things.  
Mary has chosen the better part.

### A MINDSET OF SERVICE

There’s a lot of traveling, delivering, and visiting going on in our readings today. In Genesis Abraham cares for the needs of three mysterious travelers. The psalm responds, celebrating the kind of righteousness that Abraham practices. Then, in his letter to the Colossians, Saint Paul describes his own ministry as almost like a delivery service: he, God’s steward, brings the word of God to their community.

Finally, Luke’s Gospel shares the well-known story of Mary and Martha, and the different ways they welcome Jesus into their home. Amid all this coming and going, we are invited to pay attention to the ways we tend to the needs of others. Each of us can ask, How am I present to God and others in my life?
